Location:

Start at Richmond Square
Quest around The Level, Open
Market, & North Laines.

Time To Play:

1-2 Hours

Approximate Distances:

Part 1 = one mile & Part 2 = one mile.
Total Approximately 2 miles

What You Need:

A smart phone with internet access
and a camera

Getting There:

Brighton Station 10m walk
St Peters bus Stop 1m walk
Brighton City Carpark 2m walk

Mobility Info:

Step free, uneven pavements and
moderate hills.

How To Play

Quest Type:

This Quest is in three parts,
Continuous quests, played
throughout the afternoon.

Part 1 is a spot and discover, around
The Open Market and The Level.
Part 2 is a search to solve an
anagram around the North Laines.

They are all scored separately so you
can focus one, two or all.
Part 1 is more child friendly.

The Map:

The map shows the area the quest is
played in, colour coded to each part.
You can achieve the continuous
challenges anywhere.

Difficulty:

Fairly easy but if you're not a local
you may want to sparingly use
google as needed.

How To Score

Each Questions is worth 1 point
+ any stated bonus points

Solo:

Complete part 1 or 2 or both and
check your answers against the
solutions provided and see how you
did!

In Teams:

Play in teams of 2-6, get together at
the end and check each others
answers to see who won!

interpret things in different ways.

advise electing a fair friend as judge
or agreeing on a democratic vote
for any possible disagreements.
